Advanced Diploma of Fashion Design (91078NSW)



Course Description:

The Advanced Diploma of Fashion Design aims to provide the theoretical knowledge and practical skills for students wishing to work in the fast moving and highly diverse international fashion industry. Students of this course will apply their skills in a studio style setting where both creativity and practical business application is encouraged.

At the end of the two-year Advanced Diploma, students will have the opportunity to create their own collections and showcase their talents in the fashion design area of their choosing.

Work placements give students the opportunity to consolidate the institute-based component of the course. As a student you have the opportunity to undertake work placement with the leaders in Australian Designer Fashion. For 2007-2008 work placement partners include leading Australian Designers such as Akira Isogawa.

Total study time:

2 years

- 7 terms of 10 weeks
- 1 term of 12 weeks.

Attendance Requirements:

Full time Tuesday to Friday classes are scheduled between 9.00-5.30 each day of the program. In the 1st year of study weekly hours per week are 28 hours and in 2nd year of study the weekly hours vary between 28 hours and 30 hours per week.

Costs:

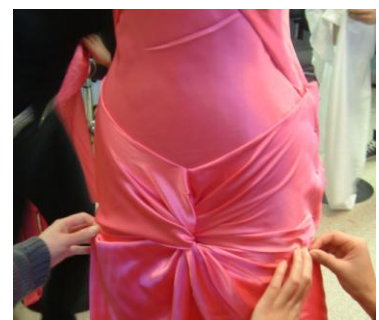
- \$16,700.00 per year, which includes all learning materials

- Fashion portfolio submission and English proficiency equivalent.
- Education level to year 10 plus IELTS 6.0 English level proficiency certificate.
