Materials charge

For some courses a small additional charge for materials is payable in full at enrolment.

Tuition fees include:

- · Meet and Greet service
- Induction programme for international students
- English language tuition during term-time if you need it
- Help with study skills
- Access to a wide range of student services and facilities

Early payment fees reductions for new students

We offer generous fees reductions against the first year fees for new students studying at Northumbria University who pay all of their fees before they start their studies with us. To be eligible for these discounts you must be a new student joining a full-time undergraduate or postgraduate programme (not an English Language preparatory programme), at Northumbria University. We offer:

- £500 reduction in fees for new students paying their full fees 6 months or more before the start date of the course.
- £350 reduction in fees for new students paying their full fees between 3 and 6 months before the start date of the course
- £200 reduction in fees for new students paying their full fees less than 3 months before the start date of the course, or on arrival.

NB: this fees reduction only applies to the first year of the programme you are studying at Northumbria University. It does not extend to second and subsequent years of study on the same programme.

Living Costs

In addition to your tuition fees, you should allow enough funds to cover living expenses for the duration of your studies. The cost of living in Newcastle is among the lowest in the UK. The amount you will need depends on your lifestyle, but we estimate that the minimum amount required by a single student to cover basic living expenses (e.g. accommodation, heating, food) is between £430 and £530 per month. For a 9-month academic year, this amounts to between approximately £4,000 and £5,000.
